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Dear Valued Customer:

I am writing to keep you up to date on a developing Mo99m/Tc99m Generator supply situation. Last week, NRG notified the industry of a problem with its High Flux Reactor (HFR) in the Netherlands. We have been notified that this reactor will be off-line for approximately one month.

We have confirmation from our generator supplier, Lantheus Medical Imaging, that GE Healthcare's generator supply will not be disrupted during the HFR shutdown. GE Healthcare pharmacy customers will continue to receive their orders as usual.

Depending on market availability, GE Healthcare pharmacies may be able to service a limited number of non GE Healthcare customers impacted by the Mo99m/Tc99m shortage. During this period we have also increased production of Thallium-201 and Indium-111 Oxine from our manufacturing facilities to help minimize the impact this will have on some specific patient procedures.
