Dear Valued Lantheus Medical Imaging Customer,

We would like to update you on our efforts to support the U.S. and Canadian Nuclear Medicine communities during the global shortage of molybdenum 99 (Mo-99) stemming from recent, and unprecedented, impacts on the global supply chain.

First and foremost, we want to assure current TechneLite[®] (Technetium Tc-99m Generator) customers that we do not anticipate any impact to standing orders that were in place as of August 24 throughout the shortage.

In addition, we have received assurance from our main Mo-99 supplier, MDS Nordion, that it will provide some incremental Mo-99 to begin to offset the supply shortfall. This week we secured a small additional quantity of Mo-99 and expect an increased supply of material for the week beginning September 7.

Our Customer Service department (1-800-299-3431) is accepting requests for the manufacture of additional generators beginning September 7, and will confirm these requests beginning today. As there will likely be many changes to orders during this supply challenge, customer-order confirmation will occur prior to each scheduled manufacturing day.

As always, we are fully committed to meeting your needs during this challenging period, although, as I am sure you can understand, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to meet every customer order placed during the shortage. We hope that our repeated demonstration of this commitment during previous supply-chain interruptions has earned your confidence that we will do whatever we can to support you and the patients that you serve.

We will provide you with more updates on the Moly-99 supply situation as events warrant.
