
How to Claim CME for ASNC2019


1. Visit the Itinerary Planner at <https://www.abstractsonline.com/pp8/#!/7885> or by using your smart phone's camera or a QR reader to read this QR code.



2. Sign in at the top right side of your screen. Sign in using your registration reference number and your last name. Your reference number is located on your badge and is also in the registration confirmation you received.



3. Select the sessions you attended. You can select by day or session type. You can also search by author or keyword in the Search bar.





- After you search for your sessions, select each radio button **Add to Credit Cart** for the sessions you attended.
