ASNC Needs to Know About

Your Prior Authorization Problems and Coverage Denials


United Healthcare (UHC) – the largest commercial health insurer in the U.S. – recently updated its payment policy to provide reimbursement for coronary CT angiography. The policy states that CCTA will be used "as a first line test to assess stable chest pain."

In response to ASNC queries, UHC said the policy does not indicate any change to approval and reimbursement for SPECT or PET testing. Unfortunately, ASNC is hearing member reports of CCTA being pushed as a first-line test

ASNC advocates for putting the patient – never any specific test – first. We need your input now. Please use this ASNC reporting form to tell us about any denials or prior authorization

The Time Has Come: Congress Must Repeal

the Medicare AUC Program

With the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) poised to implement the Medicare Appropriate Use

Criteria (AUC) Program for advanced diagnostic imaging to the fullest extent possible in 2022, ASNC continues its advocacy to put a stop to the program and redirect policymakers toward existing and emerging payment models designed to drive appropriate healthcare resource use. For seven years, CMS has struggled to implement the program, which has been fraught with complexity and

ASNC has been the leading voice asking congressional lawmakers to rethink the necessity of the program, which has grown outdated since it was established in 2014. More recently, ASNC spearheaded a letter to CMS signed by 15 other organizations requesting that the agency publicly report the obstacles to AUC Program implementation, and consider the anticipated cost and administrative burden of the program - plus its


