

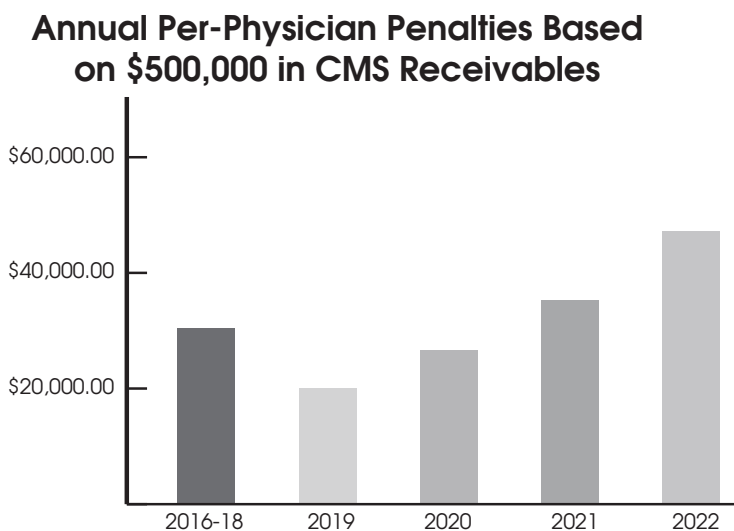

The ImageGuide Registry is the first cardiac imaging data registry aimed at tracking and improving the quality of cardiac imaging.

The ImageGuide Registry provides a one-of-a-kind opportunity to examine SPECT and PET cardiovascular imaging in a real-world setting. The Registry's standardized data collection process and benchmark reports offer labs and institutions the opportunity to access aggregate data to validate image quality, appropriate use and safety, and pinpoint opportunities for improvement. With the ability to demonstrate quality, value, and appropriate use, nuclear labs and specialists can significantly reduce CMS penalties and optimize reimbursement.

The traditional PQRS program will sunset on December 31st, 2018 and will be replaced by the Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS).
