Help build the pipeline for future Nuclear Cardiologists! This dynamic program will take place in Atlanta, Georgia, just prior to the ACC Annual Scientific Session. Nuclear Cardiology Show-a-Case with Fellows-in-Training (FIT) will provide an engaging and collegial environment in which 50 expected attendees can interact with expert faculty.

This year the ASNC FIT program will feature a NEW meeting format. The 5-hour session will frame fellow case presentations with expert perspectives. Attendees will participate in fast-paced interactive case presentations "for FITs by FITs". The program will be divided into five sections, each section addressing aspects of imaging that fellows will encounter during nuclear cardiology training. Cases will be presented by the fellows to experts in the field and to other fellows for discussion. Brief didactic presentations will establish key teaching points in the five program areas. This new format will allow FITs to become more engaged in the program and focus on issues most important to their continuing education. The five areas for discussion include:

- Diagnosis and risk stratification with stress perfusion imaging
- Additive clinical value of myocardial blood flow
- Imaging infection and inflammation
- Radionuclide imaging in cardiac amyloidosis
- Application of hybrid imaging in routine clinical practice
