

Barry L. Zaret Young Investigator Competition Presenter Guidelines

Session Overview

The <u>Barry L. Zaret Young Investigator Competition</u> is a 70-minute long session featuring three emerging science and three clinical science oral abstract presentations. Each competitor will give a 7-minute presentation and have 4 minutes to respond to questions from the judges and session attendees.

Two first-prize winners, one from each category, will be announced on Saturday, September 7 at 8:30am CT during Saturday morning's plenary session, Multimodality Imaging in Cardiovascular Infection.

Arrival Time to Session Room

Please arrive at the session room no less than 15 minutes prior to the start of the session. You will be greeted by the session moderator who will confirm the order in which you will be presenting and provide any last minute instructions.

Required Slides

Slide 1 should be your title slide and slide 2 should be your disclosure slide. Your current disclosures must be included in your PowerPoint presentation and be shown at the start of your presentation.

Use of Product/Brand Names

Do not include product/brand names or logos in your presentation. However, institution logos (i.e., non-PhRMA related logos such as university names, associations, and government agencies) are allowed in the body of your presentation. If it is necessary to reference a commonly used brand name or product, the scientific or generic name should be referenced next to it. *Example: Acetaminophen (Tylenol)*

PowerPoint Slide Template

Please visit the <u>ASNC2024 Presenter Resources</u> page to download the official ASNC2024 PowerPoint slide template. Use of the template is encouraged, but optional. If you do not want to use ASNC's template we ask that you use a plain white PowerPoint background.

Submitting Your Slide Presentation
