



Rapid-Fire Session Presenter Guidelines

Session Overview

ASNC2024 [Rapid Fire Sessions](#) are 50 minutes long and consist of approximately 8-10 case presentations. Presenters will stand at a large 65" monitor and present their accepted case over a two minute period. Following each presentation there will be an additional two (2) minutes of moderated Q&A.

Arrival Time to Session Room

Please arrive at the session room no less than 10 minutes prior to the start of the session. You will be greeted by the session moderator who will confirm the order in which you will be presenting and provide any last minute instructions.

Presentation Format

Please prepare a PowerPoint presentation consisting of 1-4 slides. The maximum number of slides is four (4).

There is not an option to present virtually. All presenters must attend ASNC2024 in person in Austin, Texas. If you are unable to attend in person, please contact Kelly Fischer (kfischer@asnc.org) as soon as possible so we can remove your case presentation from its assigned session.

Your current disclosures should be included in your PowerPoint presentation.
